Rules and regulations

GENERAL RULES

1. College working days are from Monday to Saturday
2. General timing: 10 am- 4.30 pm, except Saturday 10 am-1pm
3. Students should maintain professional and ethical standards of behaviour both in college and hospital.
4. Mass bunk in any condition is not allowed. Disciplinary action will be taken against all involved students.
5. During college hours no students is allowed to move outside the college campus (except during lunch time) without taking permission from the Principal or Class In charge.
6. College authorities will not be responsible for loss/damage of any property such as mobile, jewellery etc. of the students.
7. In case the students go for hiking/tours/picnics organized by Private groups or unofficially on their own, the college will not bear responsibility for any incident. It will be at student's own risk.
8. The areas near classrooms are "Silence Zone". Students are advised not to make noise in this zone.
9. No student is permitted to approach management directly in any instances.
10. Submission of annual fees is mandatory as per schedule.

Academic Rules

1. Attendance: Usually mandatory (often 75-90%) for both theory and clinical practice.
2. Examinations: Regular internal assessments, practical exams, and final university exams must be passed.
3. Assignments & Records: Students must complete clinical requirements, case studies, clinical records, and project work on time.
4. Progression: Failure in key subjects may require repeating the year or supplementary exams.

Clinical / Practical Training Rules

1. Clinical Posting: Mandatory participation in hospital training.
2. Patient Care Ethics: Maintain confidentiality, respect patient dignity, and follow hospital protocols.
3. Uniform & Appearance: Proper nursing uniform, ID badge, clean shoes, tied hair, minimal jewelry.
4. Punctuality: Strict adherence to clinical duty timings.

Professional Conduct

1. Respect faculty, staff, patients, and peers.
2. No involvement in malpractice, negligence, or unethical behavior.
3. Follow principles taught in Nursing Ethics.
4. Maintain discipline both inside and outside campus.

Campus Discipline Rules

1. Ragging: Strictly prohibited under laws like the UGC Anti-Ragging Regulations.
2. Attendance in Events: Participation in seminars, workshops, and community programs is compulsory.
3. Behaviour: No violence, harassment, or substance abuse.
4. Use of Mobile Phones: Often restricted in classrooms and clinical areas.

Health & Safety Rules

1. Mandatory vaccinations (e.g., Hepatitis B).
2. Regular health check-ups.
3. Follow infection control practices (hand hygiene, PPE usage).
4. Training in emergency procedures.

Legal & Regulatory Compliance

1. Nursing colleges in India are regulated by bodies like the Indian Nursing Council and respective State Nursing Councils.
2. Students must comply with professional standards set by these authorities.

Uniform & Identity

1. Wearing college uniform and ID card is compulsory on campus and in hospitals.
2. Dress code violations may lead to disciplinary action.

Uniform rules and regulations for nursing students

Uniform rules for nursing students are strict because they reflect professionalism, hygiene, and patient safety. While details vary slightly by college, most institutions follow these standard guidelines:

Basic Uniform Requirements

1. Wear the prescribed nursing uniform.
2. Uniform must be clean, neatly ironed, and well-fitted.
3. Carry a college ID card at all times.
4. Wear closed, comfortable shoes (usually Black; no sandals or heels).

Personal Hygiene & Grooming

1. Daily bathing and overall cleanliness are essential.
2. Nails must be short, clean, and without nail polish (to prevent infection spread).
3. Maintain good oral hygiene and avoid strong perfumes.

Hair Guidelines

1. Hair should be neatly tied (bun or plait).
2. Long hair must be secured; loose hair is not allowed in clinical areas.
3. Hair accessories should be simple (preferably black or white).

Jewelry & Accessories

1. Minimal jewelry allowed:
2. Small stud earrings (if permitted)
3. Simple wristwatch (preferably with a second hand for clinical use)
4. Avoid: Rings, bangles, necklaces
5. Fancy or dangling accessories

Clinical Area Rules

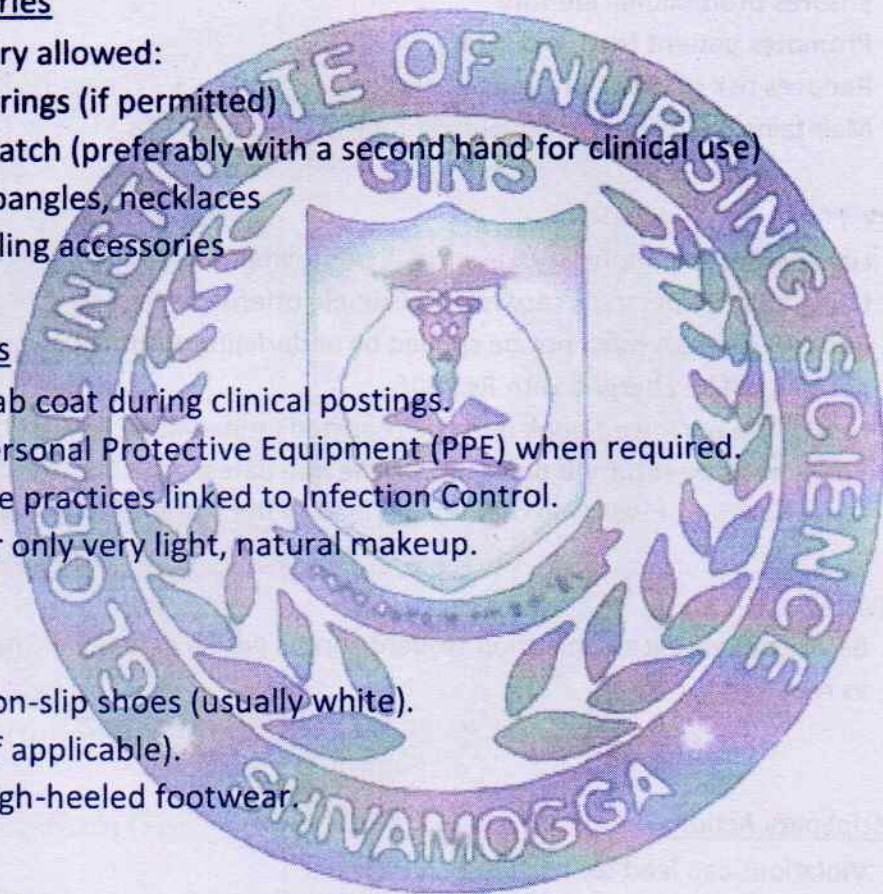
1. Wear apron/lab coat during clinical postings.
2. Use proper Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) when required.
3. Follow hygiene practices linked to Infection Control.
4. No makeup or only very light, natural makeup.

Footwear Rules

1. Closed-toe, non-slip shoes (usually white).
2. Clean socks (if applicable).
3. No noisy or high-heeled footwear.

Prohibited Practices

1. Wearing casual clothes instead of uniform during duty.
2. Long or artificial nails.
3. Visible tattoos (in some institutions).
4. Strong fragrances or heavy cosmetics.



Discipline & Compliance

1. Uniform must be worn:
2. During classes (if required by college)
3. Always during clinical/hospital duty
4. Non-compliance may result in:
5. Being sent out of class/ward
6. Marks deduction in practicals
7. Disciplinary action

Importance of Uniform Rules

1. Ensures professional identity
2. Promotes patient trust and safety
3. Reduces risk of infection transmission
4. Maintains discipline and equality among students

Library

1. Library card is compulsory for entry & borrowing.
2. Using another person's card is a punishable offense.
3. Books & journals must not be spoiled by underlining, writing or tearing pages. In case of it the penalty will be charged with Rs.500/-.
4. Loss of the borrowed book must be reported immediately & must be replaced a new copy.
5. Books must be returned on or before the due dates.
6. Misbehaviour or violation of rules can lead to the suspension of library privileges.

Examination

1. Before appearing examination student should get no due certificate from all the departments as required.

Disciplinary Actions

1. Violations can lead to:
2. Warnings or fines
3. Suspension from classes or clinical postings
4. Expulsion in serious cases

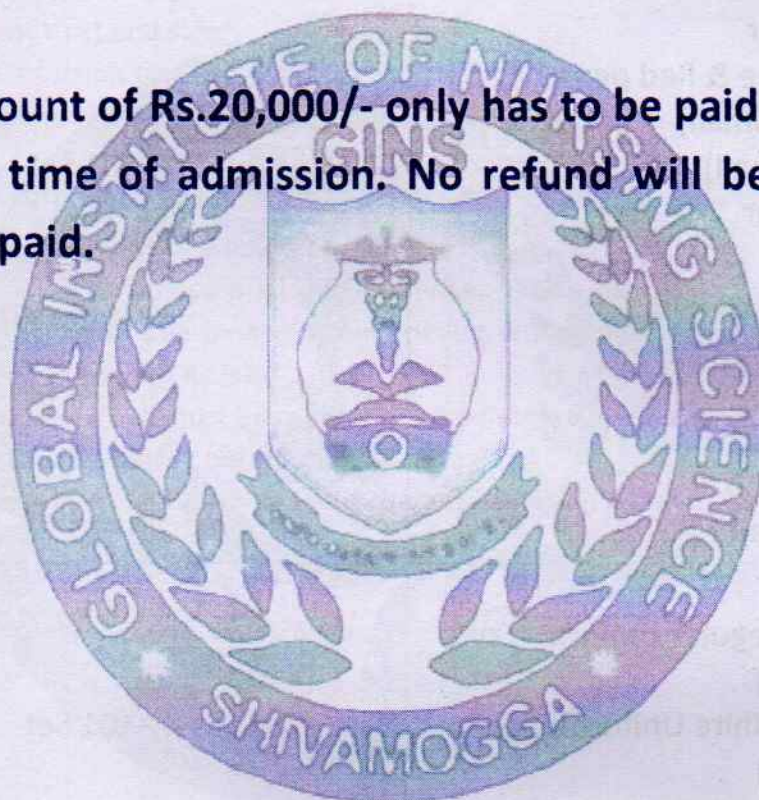

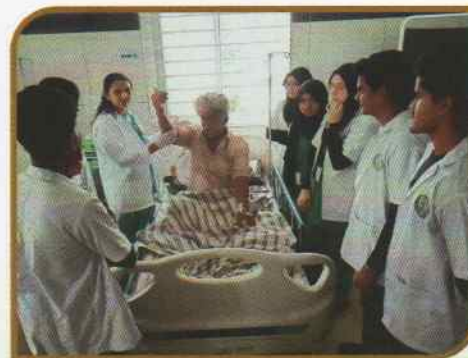
